## The Law and Judgment (Romans 2:12-24)

- 1. This section is an application of the principles established in verses 1-11. Some Jews harshly judged the Gentiles because they did not have the Old Testament law. These same Jews, who had received the law, did not keep the law faithfully. The bottom line is going to be that all need to obey the gospel.
