## Mark Chapter 5:1-20

## Sunday January 31, 2021

In this lesson Jesus is confronted by a man who roams the countryside of the Gadarenes, living among the tombs or graveyards. We find him screaming day and night in the mountains and using sharp stones to cut himself. No one has been successful in capturing or restraining him. He can break free from any type of restraints due to his extraordinary strength. He is a man possessed with an unclean spirit and wanting to meet Jesus.

3.	Did the unclean spirit know who Jesus was? (v6)

6.	Mark and Luke mention only one man with an unclean spirit while Matthew records there were two.
	Is this a contradiction? (Mt 8:28, Mk 5:2)
7.	What two things did the unclean spirit not want Jesus to do? (v7,10)
	The unclean spirits name was Legion, where else is that word used in the New Testament?  (Mt 26:53)
	What request was made by all the demons? (v12)
	What happened after the unclean spirits entered the large herd of swine? (v13)
l1.	What was the reaction of those who witnessed the destruction of the swine herd and saw the
	demon possessed man in his right mind? (v15)
l2.	As Jesus prepares to leave, the man who had the unclean spirit removed begged what of Jesus? (v18
3	Did lesus approve the healed man's request? (v19)

Are there any lessons for us that we can take from Jesus and his encounter with an unclean spirit?
